

ADDENDUM NO. 1

VILLAGE OF BYESVILLE SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION – PHASE II

Bids will be received until **11:00 A.M., local time, July 18, 2019. REVISED**

This Addendum to the Project Manual is issued to modify, explain or correct the original Project Manual and is hereby made part of the Contract Documents. Insert the number of this Addendum in the blank space provided in the Bid Form, Section 00400, page 1.

A. DIVISION 0 – BIDDING AND CONTRACTING REQUIREMENTS

1. SECTION 00100 – INVITATION TO BID

- a. The date of the bid opening for this project has been revised to July 18, 2019. The time scheduled for the bid opening remains unchanged. REPLACE all date references to the Bid Opening within the Invitation to Bid with the revised Bid Opening date of July 18, 2019.

2. SECTION 00400 – BID FORM

- a. REPLACE Section 00400, Bid Form. The Bid Form has been revised to reflect modification to the project pay items. The revised Bid Schedule, annotated “Addendum No. 1 – July 8, 2019” has been attached to this addendum. All bids submitted for the project must utilize the revised Bid Form. Any bids submitted that do not utilize the revised Bid Form shall be deemed non-responsive.

3. SECTION 00800 – SUPPLEMENTARY CONDITIONS

- a. Page 00800-11; ARTICLE 5 – BONDS AND INSURANCE.

ADD Item SC-5.11 as follows:

SC-5.11 Add the following new General Condition immediately after Paragraph 5.10.

SC-5.11 Contractor Railroad Insurance Requirements

A. Prior to the commencement of installation or maintenance of the Work or entry on the property of Independence Rail Works, Ltd. (Railway), the Contractor shall procure and maintain for the course of said installation and maintenance, a general liability policy naming Railway as an additional insured, and containing products and completed operations and

contractual liability coverage, with a combined single limit of not less than \$1,000,000 for each occurrence.

B. The referenced insurance shall be with an acceptable insurance company authorized to do business in the State of Ohio, and shall be obtained before the execution of the Agreement by Owner and kept in effect until all work required to be performed under the terms of the Agreement is satisfactorily completed as evidenced by the Engineer issuing a Certificate of Final Completion.

C. The referenced insurance shall be underwritten by insurers and shall be of such form and content as may be acceptable to Railway. Prior to commencement of installation or maintenance of the Work or any entry on Railway property, the Contractor shall furnish to Railway's Risk Manager, Attn: Troy Hindel, 3401 East Pike, Zanesville, OH 43701 (or such other representative and/or address subsequently given by Railway to Owner in writing), for approval, a certificate of insurance evidencing the existence of a policy with the coverage as outlined in Paragraph 5.11.A.

D. Contractor shall provide a copy of the certificate of insurance evidencing the existence of a policy with the coverage as outlined in Paragraph 5.11.A. to Owner within seven (7) calendar days after the award of the contract or such other time designated by the Engineer.

4. SECTION 00880 – PREVAILING WAGE REQUIREMENTS

- a. Page 00880-1; ARTICLE 1, GENERAL, Paragraph 1.02.

REPLACE General Decision OH20190001, Modification Number 7, dated 06/21/2019 that was provided as referenced in Paragraph 1.02 with General Decision OH20190001, Modification Number 8, dated 06/28/2019 as attached to this addendum. Bidders shall utilize this revised decision when compiling their Bid.

B. DIVISION 1 – GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. SECTION 01010 – SUMMARY OF WORK

- a. Page 01010-4; PART 1 – GENERAL, Paragraph 1.06., PROTECTION OF WORK AND IMPROVEMENTS.

ADD Paragraph 1.06.F. as follows:

F. Where work to be undertaken by the Contractor has the potential for impacting the sanitary facilities of residences and/or businesses or their operation within the work corridor, the Contractor shall provide notice to

those residences and/or businesses no later than 48 hours in advance of the potential impact. The notices shall be provided via door hangers delivered to each location that will be potentially impacted. The notice shall describe the intended activity, its start date and time, anticipated time and date of completion of the activity, work hours (if applicable) and any warnings or other general information necessary. The Owner will cooperate and provide assistance to the Contractor in informing the public of the anticipated work.

C. DIVISION 2 – SITE WORK

1. SECTION 02755 – CIPP LINING

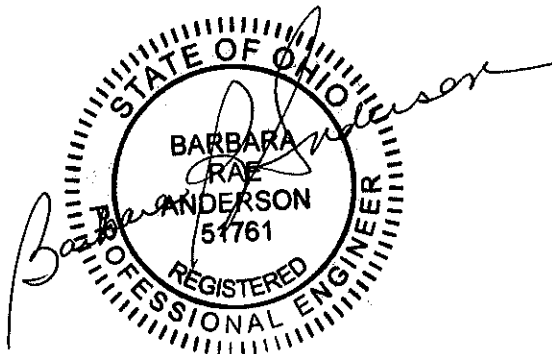
- a. Page 02755-16; PART 3 – EXECUTION, Paragraph 3.05.H., MANHOLE CONNECTIONS AND RECONNECTIONS OF EXISTING SERVICES.
