SECTION 105300 - METAL CANOPIES

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.1 RELATED DOCUMENTS

A. Drawings and general provisions of the Contract, including General and Supplementary Conditions and Division 01 Specification Sections, apply to this Section.

1.2 SUMMARY

- A. Section Includes:
 - 1. Aluminum, cantilevered overhead canopy.

1.3 ACTION SUBMITTALS

- A. Product Data: For each canopy type.
- B. Shop Drawings:
 - 1. Include plans, elevations, sections, details, and attachments to other work.
 - 2. Indicate sizes of metal sections, thickness of metals, profiles, holes, and field joints.
 - 3. Indicate locations of anchors, weld plates, and blocking for attachment of wall-mounted handrails.
- C. Delegated-Design Submittal: For canopies, including analysis data signed and sealed by the qualified professional engineer responsible for their preparation.
- D. Samples for Initial Selection: Manufacturer's color charts showing the full range of colors available.
- E. Samples for Verification: For each color required, provide Samples no less than 6 inches by 6 inches in size.

1.4 INFORMATIONAL SUBMITTALS

- A. Qualification Data: For professional engineer's experience with providing delegated-design engineering services of the kind indicated, including documentation that engineer is licensed in the State in which Project is located.
- B. Sample Warranties: For special warranties.

1.5 QUALITY ASSURANCE

A. Installer Qualifications: An authorized representative who is trained and approved by manufacturer.

1.6 FIELD CONDITIONS

- A. Field Mesurements: Confirm field dimensions prior to preparation of shop drawings when possible.
- B. Deliver and store all canopy components in dry, protected areas.

1.7 WARRANTY

- A. Special Warranty: Manufacturer agrees to repair or replace components of canopies that fail in materials or workmanship within specified warranty period.
 - 1. Failures include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - a. Structural failures including, but not limited to, excessive deflection.
 - b. Deterioration of metals, metal finishes, and other materials beyond normal weathering and use; rust through.
 - c. Delamination of exterior or interior facing materials.
 - 2. Warranty Period: Five years from date of Substantial Completion.
- B. Special Finish Warranty: Manufacturer agrees to repair or replace components that show evidence of deterioration of factory-applied finishes within specified warranty period.
 - 1. Warranty Period: 10 years from date of Substantial Completion.

PART 1 - PRODUCTS

2.1 METAL CANOPIES

- A. Products: Basis of Design: Subject to compliance with requirements, provide a cantilevered canopy from Mapes Industries, Inc., or a comparable product from another manufacturer.
- B. Materials:
 - 1. Decking shall consist of a 2 3/4" extruded .078" decking.
 - 2. Intermediate framing members shall be extruded aluminum, alloy 6063-T6, in profile and thickness standard with manufacturer.

- 3. Hanger rods and attachment hardware shall be a standard finish.
- 4. Fascia shall be manufacturer's standard extruded fascia.
- 5. Finish: Two-coat fluoropolymer (Kynar) finish.
 - a. Colors: As selected by Architect from manufacturer's full range

C. Fabrication:

- 1. Extruded aluminum canopies are shipped with the materials precut to size for field assembly.
- 2. All connections shall be mechanically assembled utilizing 3/16 inch fasteners with a minimum shear stress of 350 lb. Pre-welded or factory-welded connections are not acceptable.
- 3. Concealed drainage. Water shall drain from covered surfaces into intermediate trough and be directed to scuppers or downspouts.

PART 2 - EXECUTION

3.1 EXAMINATION

- A. Examine surrounding areas and substrates where canopy is to be installed with Installer present, for compliance with requirements for installation tolerances, and other conditions affecting performance of the Work.
- B. Proceed with installation only after unsatisfactory conditions have been corrected.

3.2 INSTALLATION OF METAL CANOPIES

A. Installation shall be in strict accordance with manufacturer's shop drawings. Particular attention should be given to protecting the finish during handling and erection.

3.3 CLEANING AND PROTECTION

- A. Touch up damaged finishes immediately upon completion of installation. Replace components that cannot be restored to their original finish.
- B. After installation, clean entire canopy and protect from damage until Substantial Completion.
