The Ohio Minority Engineering Student Scholarship Program sponsored by CT Consultants, Inc., in conjunction with the Ohio Legislative Black Caucus (OLBC), National Society of Black Engineers (NSBE), and New Visions Group provides **Financial Assistance** and **Possible Internship Opportunities** to minority students enrolled in a civil engineering program at an accredited Ohio College or University.

The Ohio Minority Engineering Student Scholarship Program includes:

- Four (4) \$2,500.00 scholarships awarded each year.
- Student(s) can maintain multi-year scholarships if they continue to fulfill program requirements.
- Recipients may be eligible for internship and mentoring opportunities.
- The program will be marketed to accredited Ohio Colleges and Universities that have Engineering programs.

To be eligible for this scholarship program, applicants must:

- Be an Black/African descent student enrolled in an accredited Ohio College or University civil engineering program.
- Students must be declared as an Engineering Major and focus on Civil Engineering.
- Maintain reasonable standard of conduct, as defined by the Ohio Minority Student Scholarship Program selection Committee, expected of scholarship students.

I. Purpose

To provide financial assistance to Black/African descent students enrolled in a Civil Engineering program at an accredited Ohio College or University.

II. Parameters

- Four (4) \$2,500.00 scholarships per year to a Black/African descent student enrolled in a Civil Engineering Program at an Accredited Ohio College or University.
- Renewable, upon reapplication by the student, for up to three academic years.
- Scholarship money is paid directly to the College or University prior to the start of the academic year.

III. Application Timelines

- We consider applications on a rolling basis. You are encouraged to apply as soon as possible to be considered for awards beginning in January, May, or August. The application is a multi-step process.

IV. Minimum Requirements for Renewal Selection Criteria

- Scholarships intended for full-time students entering or attending a Civil Engineering program at an accredited Ohio College or University.

- Completed scholarship application form.
- Complete a minimum 500 word essay of the need for engineers in today's workforce and why the applicant intends to practice in this field.
- Official transcripts reflecting current GPA.
- Three attached letters of recommendation from, but not limited to, former teachers, college administrators, community leaders, counselors, etc.
- A personal or telephone interview.
