

Invitation to Manufacturers for Statements of Qualifications

The Village of Piketon is hereby soliciting Qualifications Submittals (non-price based) and subsequently Proposals (price-based) from manufacturers of Wastewater Treatment Plant activated sludge and aerobic digestion process equipment that qualifies as either a sequenced batch reactor, extended aeration system or oxidation ditch. This solicitation process will determine the most responsible and cost-effective manufacturer. Sealed Qualifications Submittals will be received at Village Hall, 411 South West Street, Piketon, Ohio 45661 until 2:00 PM on October 21, 2020 for the

Qualifications Submittals shall consist of pertinent design data, drawings, etc., to determine if a manufacturer is qualified for the application at this plant.

Following a review of the Qualifications Submittals as described herein, proposals from manufacturers found qualified will be requested and received by the Village 14 days from notification of being qualified for proposal submittal.

Subsequent proposals from notified manufacturers shall consist of additional/more detailed information on the equipment, the required proposal forms, and a lump sum price that will be used to complete a Best Value evaluation of complete activated sludge and aerobic digestion process, inclusive of manufacturer's equipment, associated ancillary equipment, appurtenances, and operation and maintenance costs.

Based on a "Best Value" evaluation, the Village intends to select one manufacturer to enter into an agreement (contract) to provide the equipment and services. The Village will then assign the agreement to the general construction contractor for the WWTP.

The Village reserves the right to reject or accept any and all Qualifications Submittals or to waive any and all informalities and the right to disregard all non-conforming or non-responsive Submittals.

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
