Each bidder is required to furnish with his proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with State of Kentucky Requirements. Bid security furnished in Bond form shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Kentucky to provide said surety. Submitted proposals must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the same and all persons interested therein.

When the total overall project equals or exceeds \$75,000 all bidders must comply with the Prevailing Wage rates on Public Improvements in Kenton County and the City of Covington, Kentucky, as ascertained and determined by the Administrator of the State of Kentucky Requirements. Prevailing Wage Law will apply to this project.

All Contractors and subcontractors involved with the project will, to the extent practicable use Kentucky Products, materials, services, and labor in the implementation of their project.

The Housing Authority of Covington, Kentucky, reserves the right to waive irregularities and to reject any or all bids.
