
SECTION 7
SPECIFIC PROJECT REQUIREMENTS

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1 - CONTACT DURING BIDDING

- 1.1 All questions during bidding should be addressed to Bill Baker, P.E., who can be reached at CT Consultants, Inc., 8150 Sterling Court, Mentor, Ohio 44060 at (440) 530-2247.

2 - PAVEMENT CORING REPORT

- 2.1 A pavement coring report dated 3/22/21 by CT Consultants, Inc. was relied upon by the Engineer in the preparation of drawings and specifications. Copies of the report are provided along with each bid set but are not considered to be part of the bid documents.

3 - ASBESTOS SURVEY REPORT

- 3.1 An asbestos survey report dated December 12, 2022 by HZW Environmental Consultants, LLC was relied upon by the Engineer in the preparation of drawings and specifications. Copies of the report are provided along with each bid set but are not considered to be part of the bid documents.

4 - REFERENCE DRAWINGS

- 4.1 Reference Drawings dated 1929 of the Combination Arch & Girder Bridge were relied upon by the Engineer in the preparation of drawings and specifications. Copies of the drawings may be examined on the internet at www.ctconsultants.com/bidinfo/index.html but are not considered to be part of the bid documents.

5 - CORRECTION PERIOD

- 5.1 The Correction Period in Section 13.07 of the General Conditions shall be changed from a one (1) year to a two (2) year period.

6 - INSURANCE

- 6.1 Section SC-5.04(D) of the Supplementary Conditions shall be deleted and no "all risk builders risk" or "installation floater" insurance need be purchased by the Contractor.

7 - WORKING HOURS

- 7.1 No work shall be performed between the hours of 7:00 PM and 7:00 AM nor on Saturday, Sunday, or legal Holidays, without written permission of the Owner.

8 - PROJECT COMPLETION

- 8.1 All work including restoration and clean-up shall be completed no later than the contract completion date. Failure to complete all work within the allotted time will result in assessment of liquidated damages. Upon completion of all work and written notification of same by the Contractor, the Engineer and Owner will compile a punch list. The punch list will be sent to the Contractor. All punch list work shall be completed to the satisfaction of the Engineer and the Owner within 14 days after receipt of the punch list. Failure to complete the punch list work within the allotted time will result in assessment of liquidated damages.

9 - ASPHALT GRINDINGS

- 9.1 All grindings shall become the property of the Contractor.

10 - START DATE

- 10.1 All work to start March 1, 2023 and be completed by June 30, 2023. 122 Calendar Days

11 - SITE ACCESS

- 11.1 Access to the site for field investigation of existing conditions must be scheduled in advance with the Owner by contacting Mr. Kevin Lemmo, Park Superintendent, who can be reached at (440) 836-5388.

12 - PAYMENTS

- 12.1 See EJCDC C-700 Standard General Conditions of the Construction Contract Article 14 - Payments to Contractor and Completion.
- 12.2 This project is being funded in whole or in part by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, Community Development Block Grant Program. The Contractor shall comply with all requirements of this program. In paragraph 14.02 C.1. of the General Conditions, change "ten days" to "sixty days."

13 - CDBG RECIPIENT HOLD HARMLESS

- 13.1 The Owner and Contractor agree to hold the Ashtabula County Board of Commissioners (CDBG Recipient) harmless from and against claims, damages, losses, and expense, including but not limited to attorney's fees, arising out of or resulting from negligence or misconduct in relation to the work defined in the contract.
